DAY 3 ACTIVITIES: TOILET FUNCTIONALITY & ODOR INSPECTION DRIVE

As part of the ongoing Swachhata Drive (1st – 31st August 2025), Day 3 was dedicated to the critical evaluation of sanitation facilities, specifically focusing on toilet functionality and odor control, in line with the directives issued by the Department of Health & Family Welfare, GNCTD.

Comprehensive Toilet Inspection Activity

A detailed inspection of all patient and staff toilets across OPD IPD, Emergency, and Administrative Blocks was carried out under the direct supervision of:

Dr. B. B. Prasad, Head of Office

The inspection was led on the ground by the Chief Medical Officer (CMO) and Nursing Officers on duty.

Key Inspection Points and Findings

Functionality Check:

All toilets were found to be in working condition, with functional flushing systems, taps, washbasins, and ventilation.

Odor Control:

No foul or unpleasant odor was detected in any of the inspected toilet areas. Air fresheners and proper drainage ensured a clean and fresh environment.

Cleanliness Status:

All toilets were properly cleaned. Stains, dirt, and waterlogging were absent. Floors, walls, and toilet fixtures were spotless and dry.

Maintenance Status:

Toiletries (soap) were adequately stocked. Dustbins were emptied and covered. No damage to infrastructure was reported.
